Dear Mr. Andrews,

The "Community of Man" project is accepted as one of the three major Bicentennial Projects. In June of 1975, it was approved by the City Commission.

Other projects have moved forward, through the efforts of governmental agencies and/or private parties. The Community of Man is still in abeyance. This is unfortunate for many reasons, most notably as far as the City of Miami is concerned, in that we may fail to accomplish a piece of work which will stand, in the eyes of people all over the world, and for generations to come, as a model for community development.

I would appreciate hearing from you at your earliest convenience, what it is you need in order to make available to the Steering Committee of the Community of Man Task Force, the resources of the Planning Department, which are seen as necessary for the project to proceed. At this point, these resources are:

1. An inventory of the proposed planning, Federal, State, County, City, for the mile-square Target Area.
2. Information as to works proposed, in whatever stage of conception and/or execution, for the area.
3. The time of a Planning Department staff member to go over the above information with the Task Force members. (This is probably a matter of 3-4 hours, perhaps in two separate days.)

The Project cannot go forward without the City of Miami. We will be ready to work with you as soon as your reply is in our hands.
